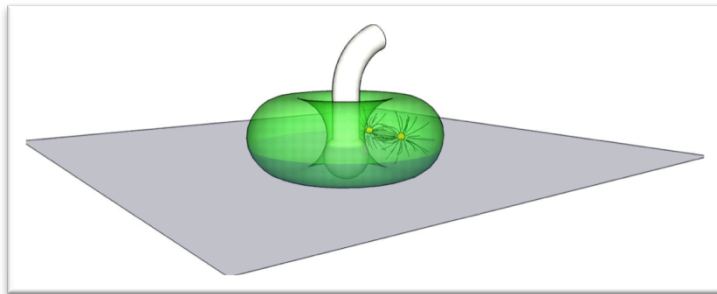


Elegant Experiments

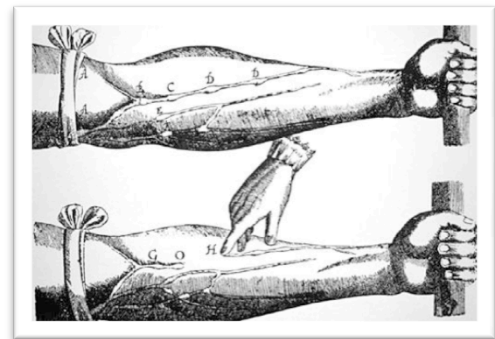
A readings/discussion course for graduate students.

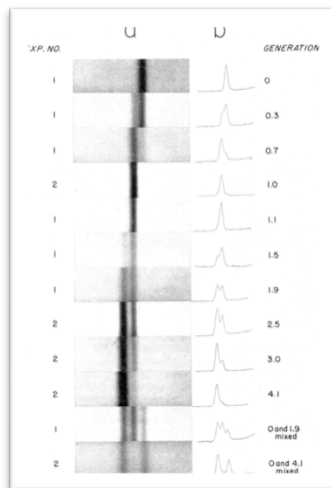
Students in the course will help choose the research papers that we will discuss.



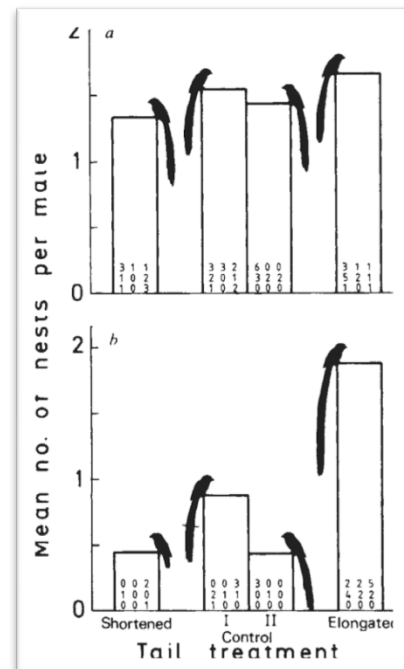
